

### **LIMRA's AML Training Enhancements**

In an effort to continually make improvements and enhancements to LIMRA's AML training program, a significant new benefit is being offered to distributors for completing the training including:

- Optional Continuing Education Credit (CE)
- Simplified Logon Screens
- Increased Online help
- And soon, the 2010 annual refresher course

LIMRA's AML course has been approved for Continuing Education credits in most states. Upon completion of the training course, distributors will have the option to complete required state-specific components for CE credit. About the course and optional CE credit:

- Cost - \$25 per course/per state (plus applicable state fees), payable by the distributors
- 50 multiple-choice questions
- Eligible for 1- 2 credit hours depending on course and state
- Available for both our Base AML Course and 2009 Refresher Course

#### ***How it Works:***

- Distributor completes (or has previously completed) the AML course through <http://nailba.limra.com> and receives an option to complete the CE module.
- If accepted, the distributor completes the enrollment process and completes a 50 question exam.
- Upon successful completion of the exam, the distributor purchases the CE module which completes the transaction and provides reporting to each requested state.

Since distributors need continuing education credit hours and Anti-Money Laundering training, this is a perfect opportunity to encourage distributors to comply with the federal requirement and earn some state-required CE credit at the same time.
